## The Hawthorne Club Luncheon

The August 21st Luncheon is a more intimate event as numbers are limited due to COVID-19 restrictions, The venue is The Newcastle Club.

This will be a special event with Wallaby assistant coach **Scott Wisemantel** as Guest of Honour. Recruited by Dave Rennie earlier this year, Scott is a well-travelled and well respected coach, having had stints at some of the top clubs around the world. He played both union and league at club level for the Parramatta Eels and Eastwood Rugby Union Club.

Scott ventured into coaching after his playing days, working with Toyota Verblitz and a short stint in France with AS Montferrand before returning to Australia to work with The Waratahs and the Australian under 19's as well as travelling with the test team to the 2007 World Cup as skills coach.

Two seasons at The Waratahs as backs coach followed before he travelled to the 2011 Rugby World Cup as a specialist coach with Samoa. Stints in Japan preceded and followed his stints as Lyon's backs coach, before going to his third World Cup with Japan - assisting Eddie Jones.

He joined Jake White at Montpellier after the World Cup before becoming a part of Eddie Jones' coaching staff at England on their tour to South Africa on a short-term deal that was subsequently extended until the 2015 World Cup.

This luncheon raises funds for The Hawthorne Club Rugby Investment Program which supports The Hunter Wildfires, The Hawthorne Cup (Clubs) NHRU Juniors and Junior Referee Scholarships.
